TO MAKE A REPORT

HATE CRIMES, BIAS INCIDENTS, SEXUAL HARASSMENT

A hate crime is any criminal act in which biased motive is a clear contributing factor.

A hate incident is any act—including conduct, speech or expression—in which biased motive is a clear contributing factor. Hate incidents do not have to include a criminal act.

Bias incidents are actions motivated by prejudice or hate, but may not meet the necessary elements required to be a crime.

Sexual misconduct includes unwelcome sexual conduct or contact.
