STRATEGIC THEMES: Workforce: Respond to community and workforce needs
by developing a culture of agility by creating a data-
informed continuous improvement ecosystem to establish
agile decision-making.

REPORT: Banner is the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP)
application that integrates the data and processes of
Portland Community College's administrative functions.
The ERP encompasses Human Resources, Finance,
Student Enrollment, and Financial Aid systems. The
Banner ERP system is critical to the day-to-day operation
of the College.

The College's existing contract with Ellucian for Banner
ERP System licenses and support will expire on October
1, 2021.

The Community College Rules of Procurement CCR.212
allow for the purchase of proprietary software without
additional competition. Ellucian is the sole provider of the
Banner ERP platform.

The term of the contract will be for 3 years, commencing
October 1, 2021.

Year 1 \$760,183; Year 2 \$799,300; Year 3 \$840,440

No firms are registered with the Oregon COBID office to
support this contract.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors authorizes the College to
enter into a contract with Ellucian. For the sum over 3
years of \$2,399,923.00 from the General Fund.
