# **VIR Courses**

• The new VIR (Vascular Interventional Radiography) courses were created for the new Vascular Interventional Catheterization Technology Less Than One-Year Certificate program. Industry demand is high for trained Interventional Radiography Technologists. Currently, there are no programs in Oregon, and very few regionally.

## **Resources for CCOGs**

- Should the Curriculum Committee develop rubrics for crafting CCOGs, namely, the course description and course outcomes, which are the CCOG areas on which the committee provides oversight and guidance? A kind of cheat sheet or checklist to give the SACs to aid them?
- Perhaps, a committee retreat at the end of Spring term could be scheduled to:
  - 1) document what the committee does now and why it makes the decisions it makes
  - 2) develop a revision cycle timeline and a communication strategy for keeping everyone up-to-date.
