## **Discussion:**

### **Curriculum Committee Chair**

- Doug Jones has taken leave for the rest of the academic year. Patty Hawkins is stepping in to serve as co-chair (with Magda D'Angelis-Morris). She will be officially confirmed by the EAC on March 18<sup>th</sup>.

### **Math Calculus Sequence**

- The outcome revisions were based on the new outcome format for WR courses. The only concern is that the Math SAC used nouns instead of verbs to begin each outcome and this complicates the grammar. The committee wonders if they should be changed into verb form.
  - In the future, should the committee require correct grammar? Or could the outcome header sentence be changed for the Math courses?
  - Consistency should be kept in mind when communicating standards to each SAC. This is a good topic for discussion at the committee retreat on March 18<sup>th</sup>.
- The courses titles and outcomes for MTH 251, 252, 253, 254, and 255 were revised to better align with what the Math departments at the universities are doing (a 5 course calculus sequence).
