Self-Awareness

•conscious knowledge of one's own character, feelings, motives, desires

Appreciation of Diversity and Difference

•The ability to recognize, understand and respect human diversity and differences among and between cultures and people

Independence

 $\bullet \textbf{Self-reliant}, \textbf{ not dependent on others for care or support, free from the influence/guidance/control of others } \\$

Flexibility / Adaptability

•The ability to adjust to new conditions, and changing to better suit a context or situation

Tolerance of ambiguity

•ability to respond to an event or non-event that results in uncertainty (e.g. a situation with no familiar cues or many cues to consider, or in which cues suggest the existence of different structures/norms); tolerance for unfamiliar or different

Effective Communication across cultures

• Ability to communicate verbally and in writing across various cultural backgrounds

Integrity

•the quality of being honest and having principles and consideration for personal actions

Leadership

•the ability to motivate or guide others toward the accomplishment of a common task

Cultural Intelligence

•The ability to cross divides and thrive in multiple cultures

Emotional Intelligence and Regulation

•capacity to be aware of, control and express one's emotions effectively and to handle interpersonal relationships empathetically

Empathy

•the ability to sense or experience the feelings of another person
