Use Your Phone as a Doc Cam

Instructions

Who this is for: faculty who would like to use their smart phone during a Zoom session as they would use a doc cam-showing perhaps their hands writing or a different part of your room more closely to demonstrate something to students.

- 1. Log into Online Rooms and 'start' your meeting as normal.
- 2. Then through the Zoom app <u>on your phone</u>: join your class session by entering your Meeting ID (this is found in the online rooms tab, next to your session topic title). Do not yet connect your phone to the audio.
- 3. From your phone, you will switch the camera to the back camera via the camera icon at the top of the screen (see icon to the right).
- 4. Position your phone wherever you need, and then begin your class from your main device (computer) as normal.
- 5. When you are ready to display what you need, select the arrow next to the microphone and then "**leave computer audio**", and join the audio on your phone (the video displayed will follow the audio feed) and conduct your demonstration.
- 6. When finished, leave the audio on your phone and reconnect computer audio.
