- Entrepreneurship (11-12th grade, 0.5 credit)

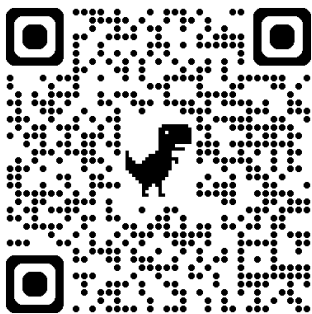
