Medical care given to only those who have no medical insurance, or can't afford medical insurance. Operates on a voucher system; if for any reason the office and lab fees are unaffordable, an arrangement is made through local organizations for you to work as a volunteer to cover the costs of your visit. Appointments preferred.

Cost: Contact Clinic directly for pricing. Blood work is more expensive than vaccines, but they will often waive 70-90% of fees for students. *Be sure to carefully read any documentation that you are given.*

Immunization documentation:

- Proof of a **negative TB** exam or clear chest x-ray within six months of the course start date and within six months of beginning the clinical rotation; or negative blood test within 12 months
- Proof of **Tetanus** must be within 10 years of the course start date and include "P" for Pertussis; we cannot accept DT or TD
- Proof of immunity to **Hepatitis B**: requires a blood test that indicates immunity to Hep B, or 1 shot for entry with follow-up of the shot series required during the course
- Proof of immunity to **MMR** (measles/mumps/rubella): requires a blood test that indicates immunity to MMR, or 2 shots. No MMR required if born before 1956
- Proof of immunity to **Varicella** (chicken pox): requires a blood test that indicates immunity to Varicella, or 2 shots; history of disease is not adequate
- Proof of **influenza** vaccination for current season
