

SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE
Making Negative Statements
Use “don’t” or “doesn’t”

“3S” has an “S” in the Simple Present . In the negative, the “s” moves from the verb to “doesn’t” Use doesn’t with he/she/it

Maria works hard.	Maria doesn’t work hard.
-------------------	--------------------------

Making Questions

Use “do” or “does”

“3S” has an “S” in the Simple Present . In questions, the “s” moves from the verb to “does”
Use DOES with he/she/it

Maria works hard.	Does Maria work hard?
