REPORT: Construction of PCC's new Southeast Center will be
completed in September 2003. It is appropriate for purposes
of signage and student/community information to consider
naming the two buildings.

Further, Board Policy B706 clearly implies the requirement
for Board approval for any building naming.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the "main" or larger building at the
new Southeast Center be named Tabor Hall. It is
recommended that the new or "wing" building that fronts on
82nd Avenue be named Scott Hall. Each of these names
stem from prominent geographic landmarks in the Southeast
area.

Director Margolin moved to approve Resolution 04-024. Following discussion, the
motion was tabled for discussion at the August 14, 2003 board meeting.
